One year after: Are you ready for the PPE Regulation now?

The PPE Regulation (2016/425) will become applicable on 21 April 2018. Economic operators, notified bodies, authorities and users are preparing for the application and are faced with questions related to the interpretation of the text and the practical implementation of the new rules.

The workshop is intended to take up those questions and try to find answers, taking account of the views of all stakeholders.

Therefore the workshop will start with a general introduction about the state of play presented by the EU Commission. The main part of the workshop will then consist of interactive discussions of the participants. To structure the discussions 4 different themes will be addressed. The moderators will give a short introduction to highlight some questions that could be addressed under the heading. The participants will then have the opportunity to share their views and experiences and suggest ways forward.

The results of the discussions will be made available to all stakeholders for the further preparation for the application of the PPE Regulation.
